[Risk of Fire and/or Electrical Danger] [give QTH of Power Line Down.]" THEN SAY - "SMOKE / [FIRE] SIGHTED" DO QWC [USE FORMAT TANGO 4]. Priority / Emergency - ...Give QTH of fire/smoke **QWS** (use FMT TANGO 4 METHODS) CALL 911 AND REPORT THE FIRE/SMOKE LOCATION.
