

SER - RADIO EVACUATION ALERTING AND RADIO COMMUNICATIONS PLAN.

AREA: VILLAGE (OTHER Areas use your CH 1 and determine your Area Procedures.

But, all must follow SER RADIO PLAN ON EROC 9 AND HAM FREQ).

- Assume and plan for a complete communications failure.
- If you are concerned, you do NOT have to wait for the Sheriff to issue an Evacuation Order.
If you decide to LEAVE because of concern, then state you are “leaving area”
E.G., “Village Foxtrot 7, leaving Village”
- Avoid using the term “EVACUATION” unless there is an EVACUATION ORDER BY SHERIFF or EVACUATION WARNING (USE THE TERMS THE SHERIFF USES). FACTS ONLY. NO OPINIONS.

1 • ANY STN CAN ACTIVATE IF THERE IS A SHERIFF ORDER. IF SO, ACTIVATE.

2 • SIGNAL 5 LONG TONES ON EROC 9 (OTHER AREAS USE – YOUR CH 1)

(note: radios in home with o/s antenna seem to work best for alerting).

**3 • ANNOUNCE: “SHERIFF HAS ISSUED EVACUATION ORDER FOR VILLAGE, ...”
SHERIFF ADVISED RESIDENTS TO USE ___[ROUTE]” [...]**

• **ANNOUNCE: “USE MOBILE NET PROCEDURE”.**

THEN, IF YOU HAVE TIME: ALERT YOUR NEIGHBORS (BANG ON DOORS / CALL YOUR PHONE TREE, ASSIST ELDERLY / DISABLED, ETC...), but get your family out.

**4 • USE *MOBILE NET PROCEDURE* (SINCE ALL LEAVING AT ONCE). WE CAN ALL LISTEN TO EROC 9 WHILE WE ARE PACKING UP, ON THE ROAD, AND Transmit VITAL INFO., ETC...)
THUS, NO FORMAL NET CONTROL. THIS WILL INVOLVE “HANDING OFF” TO NEXT STN WITH REPORT. RADIO DISCIPLINE CRITICAL.**

Use radio to Report road conditions /ask about road conditions, etc...

(Brief and to the point – no chit chat).

[E.G., “Village Foxtrot 1 Report: Location Shasta Forest Drive and Tinkerbell – Road clear moving toward 44. OUT.” [pause 3 seconds while having released PTT so any emergency traffic can come in].

Then say: “NEXT” , [if another station has report they GIVE THEIR TACTICAL AND WAIT FOR LAST STATION TO DESIGNATE THE STN TO GIVE ITS REPORT., EXAMPLE “INDIA 1, GO”]

Recommend Mag Mount Antenna on vehicles.

USE CH 40 FOR COMMS BETWEEN CARS (E.G., WIFE CAR #1; HUSB.CAR #2)

5 • WHILE YOU ARE IN THE VILLAGE, MONITOR EROC 9 (PRIMARY).

**IF YOU ALSO MONITOR CH 10, CH 13, CAL FIRE, NEWS, MOBILE ALERTS, ETC...
RELAY INFORMATION INTO THE MOBILE NET FOR EVERYONES BENEFIT.**

Chain saw crews should be ready to assist in removing road blocks (fallen trees...).

6 • AS YOU LEAVE YOUR HOUSE, DO 5 LONG BLASTS OF CAR HORN

(1 to 1.5 seconds Each BLAST) – to alert neighbors.

(periodically repeat as necessary as leaving Village). Don't block roads.

7 • UPON EXITING VILLAGE AND TURNING ONTO HIGHWAY 44

IMMEDIATELY GO TO HAM CH 10 AND/OR CH 13 TO MONITOR.

IF NEED TO TRANSMIT ROAD CONDITIONS DURING LIFE THREATENING FIRE EVACUATION (E.G., ROADS CLEAR AND THOSE NOT CLEAR, ETC) – USE CH 55 AND/OR CH 58.

8 • ON HAM USE SAME *MOBILE NET PROCEDURE* TO REPORT ROAD CONDITIONS.

E.G., “ Village Foxtrot 8 ON 55, my location is Highway 44 EAST bound at Wilson Hill Rd. Highway 44 has heavy traffic steadily moving East bound at 20 mph, out” ...[pause 3 seconds while having released PTT so any emerg. traffic can come in].]...“NEXT”...“GO (you pick next STN) ”
