

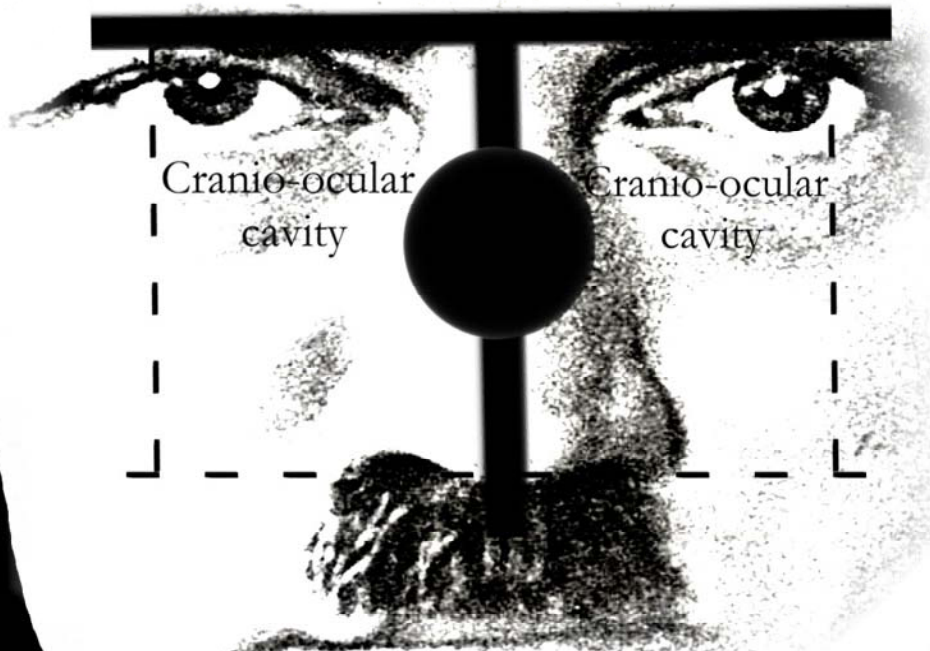

Printable Target Set: Medulla Oblongata FRONT

(Print on 8-1/2" X 11" paper)

"Even a shot to the brain is not 100% guaranteed to instantly shut off the action. The only certain "instant one shot stop" is a hit to the stem area of the brain, which destroys the medulla oblongata or pons. This is in line with the ears when aimed at from the side, and with the base of the skull when the shot must be fired from behind. The external anatomic landmark for a frontal shot will vary depending upon the position of the head. If the head is erect in the normal posture, the deep brain target will lie directly behind the nose. If the head is forward in an aggressive posture, the level of the eye sockets will be in line with the primal brain target that must be hit. If the head is thrown back as in a triumphant shout, aiming through the mouth will guide the bullet to the brain stem."
