

MOBILE EVACUATION NET SCRIPT

• Avoid using the term “EVACUATION” unless there is an EVACUATION ORDER BY SHERIFF or THERE IS AN EVACUATION WARNING ISSUED BY SHERIFF.

EVACUATIONS ARE AN EMERGENCY.

• **ANY TEAM STN [HAM OR NON HAM] CAN ACTIVATE** FOR A SHERIFF EVACUATION ORDER. ALL TEAM VOLUNTEER STNS MUST KNOW PROCEDURES, BE ABLE TO ACTIVATE, ACT AS CONTROL (TEMP CONTROL), PARTICIPATE, and FOLLOW SER PROCEDURES (BELOW). ONLY TEAM STNS CAN TX ON 55 57 56 & 58. IF YOU HEAR SHERIFF EVAC ORDER / WARNING, THEN TRANSMIT EXACTLY THE ORDER ON THE RADIOS. USE SHERIFF’S EXACT TERMS. FACTS ONLY. NO OPINIONS.

ACTIVATION AND OPS BY ANY TEAM HAM OR TEAM NON HAM

<p>• ON YOUR AREA CH 1 (VILLAGE USE 9)* (*IF YOUR RADIO HAS BEEN PROGRAMMED FOR YOUR AREA)</p> <p>DO FOLLOWING ON THE CHANNEL</p>	<p>• ON HAM 55 OR 57, AND/OR 56 OR 58. **</p> <p>** IF YOUR RADIO DOESN'T HAVE 55 56 57 58, THEN YOU CAN LISTEN ONLY USING CH 10 FROM WHICH YOU CAN LISTEN TO 55 56 57 IF YOU HAVE HAD YOUR RADIO PROGRAMMED TO LISTEN AND YOU ARE IN RANGE.</p> <p>DO FOLLOWING ON THE CHANNEL</p>

• **SIGNAL 5 LONG TONES ON CHANNEL.**

• SAY - “This is **TEMP CONTROL ON** [insert] **1** (OTHER AREAS) **9** (VILLAGE) [Area Channels] (ID THE CH YOU ARE ON)

55 57 [Ham PRIMARY REPEATERS]	(1ST CHOICE)
56 [Ham SIMPLEX] (IF REPEATERS NOT WORKING OR BAD COMMS INTO RPTRS)	(2ND CHOICE)
58	(3RD CHOICE)

“SHERIFF HAS ISSUED EVACUATION ORDER FOR [INSERT AREA],”
...SHERIFF ADVISED RESIDENTS TO USE [ROUTE] ” [...]

• SAY - “MOBILE NET ACTIVATED”. “ANY STN COPY?”
[STN RESPONDS - “India 1 copy”]

• SAY - “COPY India 1. **TEMP CONTROL [CALL SIGN / ID] OUT**”

LISTEN / HANDLE RADIO TRAFFIC ON AREA OR HAM CHANNEL AS NEEDED.
[ANY TEAM STN JUMPS IN AND ACTS AS TEMP CONTROL FOR A COMMS CYCLE]

→ **AS YOU LEAVE YOUR HOUSE**, DO 5 LONG BLASTS OF CAR HORN (1 to 1.5 seconds Each BLAST) – alerting neighbors. (Repeat as necessary as leaving Village [your Area]). Don’t block roads. On 1 or 9 **LISTEN / HANDLE RADIO TRAFFIC**

→ **UPON LEAVING YOUR AREA** (E.G., VILLAGE) & ONTO Hwy 44 (or other road) IMMEDIATELY GO TO HAM (WHERE THE ALL AREAS EVACUATION NET IS). **55 OR 57 (REPEATERS), AND/OR 56 OR 58 (SIMPLEX) TO TX & RX.** “ALL AREAS” EVAC. NET WILL BE ON THOSE HAM CHANNELS ONLY. 55 & 57 MAY BE USED JOINTLY. 56 MAY BE NEEDED .** **LISTEN / HANDLE RADIO TRAFFIC**

LISTEN / HANDLE RADIO TRAFFIC. SAME PROCEDURE ALL CHANNELS (BELOW IS A SAMPLE COMMUNICATIONS CYCLE ON 1 9 57 55 ETC.,)

“ Foxtrot 1 **REPORT. ON [INSERT CH] [E.G., 9 57 ETC...] OVER**”. [OPTIONS= “REPORT” / “NEED” / “RESPONSE”].

[ANY STN JUMP IN] “This is **TEMP CONTROL**, Foxtrot 1 GO”.

“ Foxtrot 1, RPT: My Location Shasta Forest Dr. &Tinkerbell, Road clear & moving towards HWY 44. OUT.”

“This is **TEMP CONTROL**, COPY Foxtrot 1. NEXT ... NOTHING HEARD]”

“ **TEMP CONTROL [CALL SIGN / ID] OUT**”
[pause 3 seconds while having released PTT so any emergency traffic can come in.]

[FOR ANY NEXT COMMS CYCLE, ANY DIFFERENT station jumps in and acts as TEMP CONTROL]
